ABOUT COPENHAGEN

POPULATION

Denmark has a population of 5.3 million people, of whom seven per cent are of foreign origins.

1.7 million people live in the Greater Copenhagen Area. The Øresund Region, consisting of Copenhagen and southern Sweden (Skåne), has a total population of 2.8 million inhabitants.

WEATHER

Our climate follows four distinct seasons. The temperatures vary considerably during the year, particularly during the winter period.

July is normally the warmest month with an average temperature of just below 20°C.

February is generally the coldest, with an average of just below 0°C.

September has an average temperature of 12.7 °C, 73 mm of rain and 128 hours of sunshine.

ATTRACTIONS

Major attractions in Copenhagen are: Christiania, The National gallery, The Little Mermaid, the harbour area and The Royal Castle.
